We have a historic collection recorded in Taiwan in the 1950's by John Whitehorn, which we have just made freely available online. John Whitehorn has given us a copy of a pamphlet which compliments the audio recordings, the pamphlet is called 'He Led them On. The Story of the Christian Movement Among the Paiwan Tribe of Formosa'. The pamphlet first published in November 1955 states that copyright belongs to The British and Foreign Bible Society.
