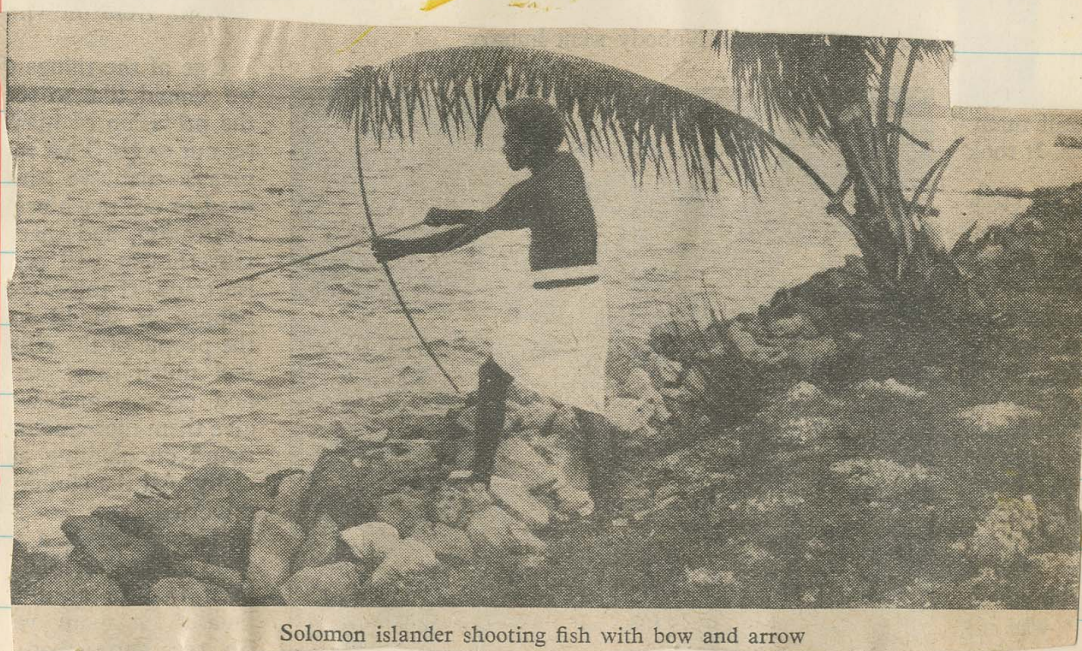

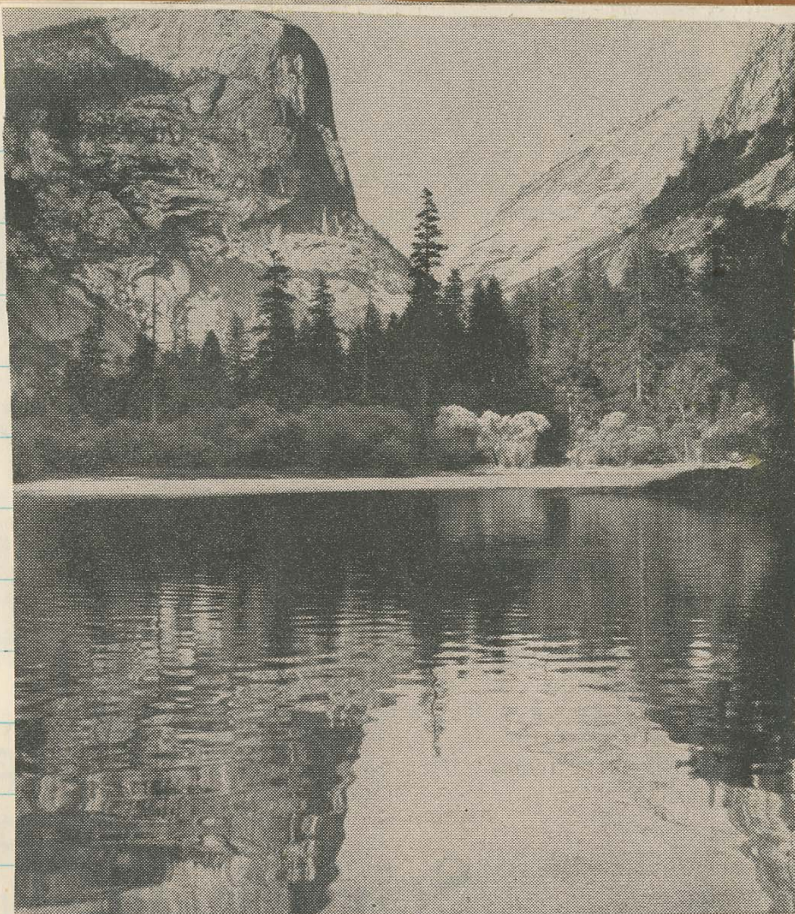
Fiji Islands

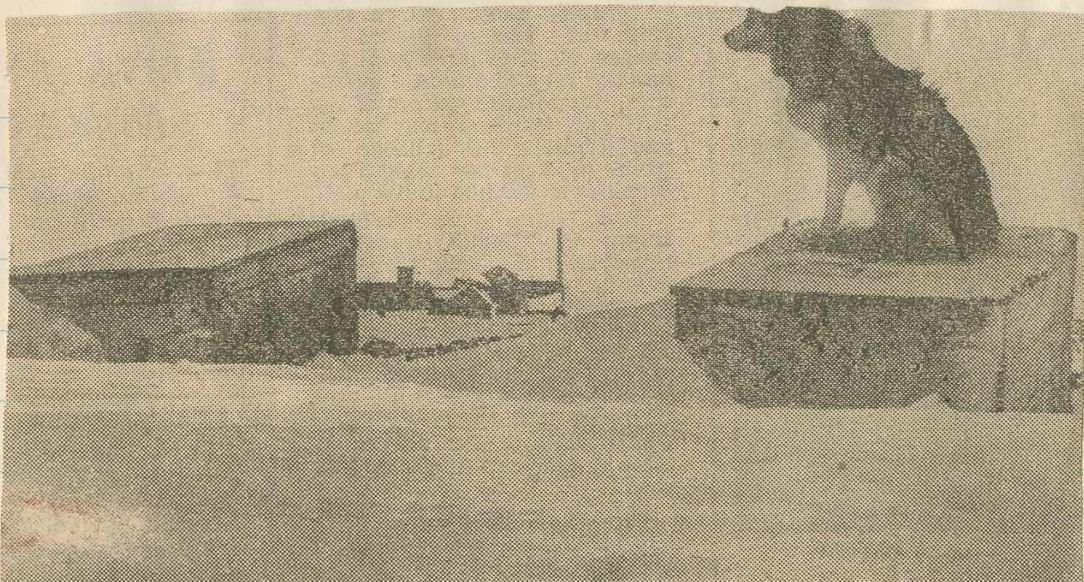

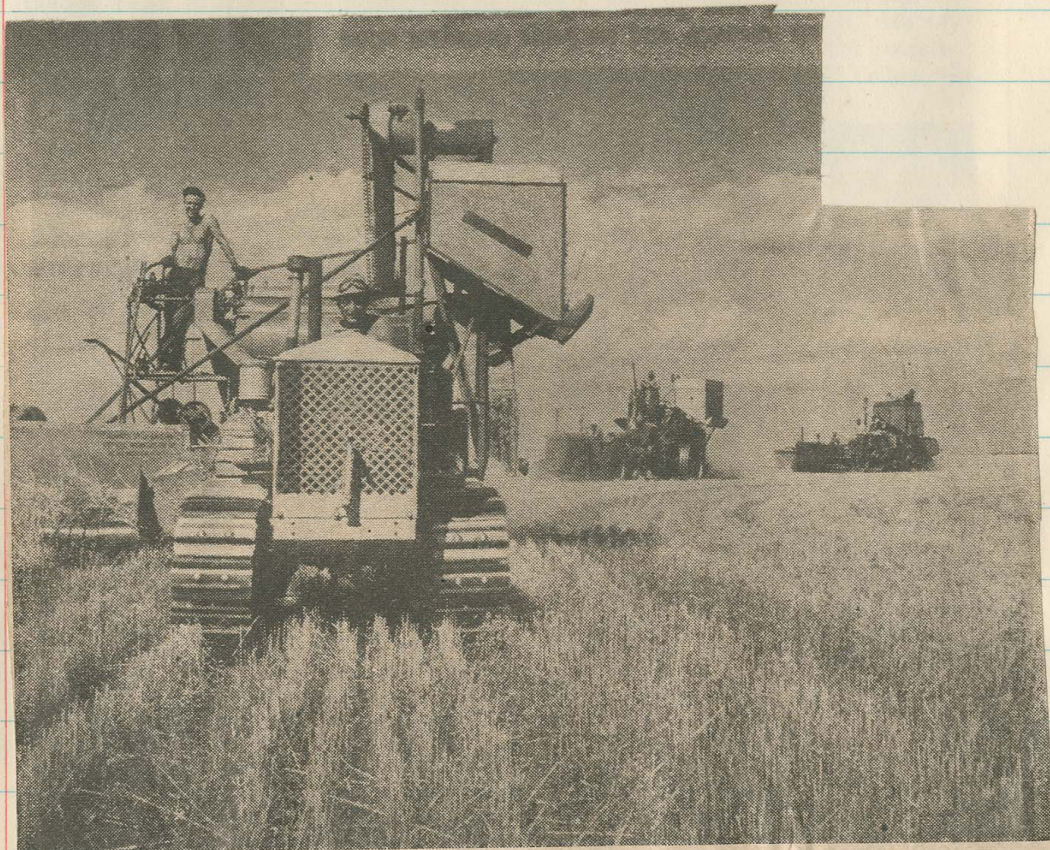

A Canadian Husky

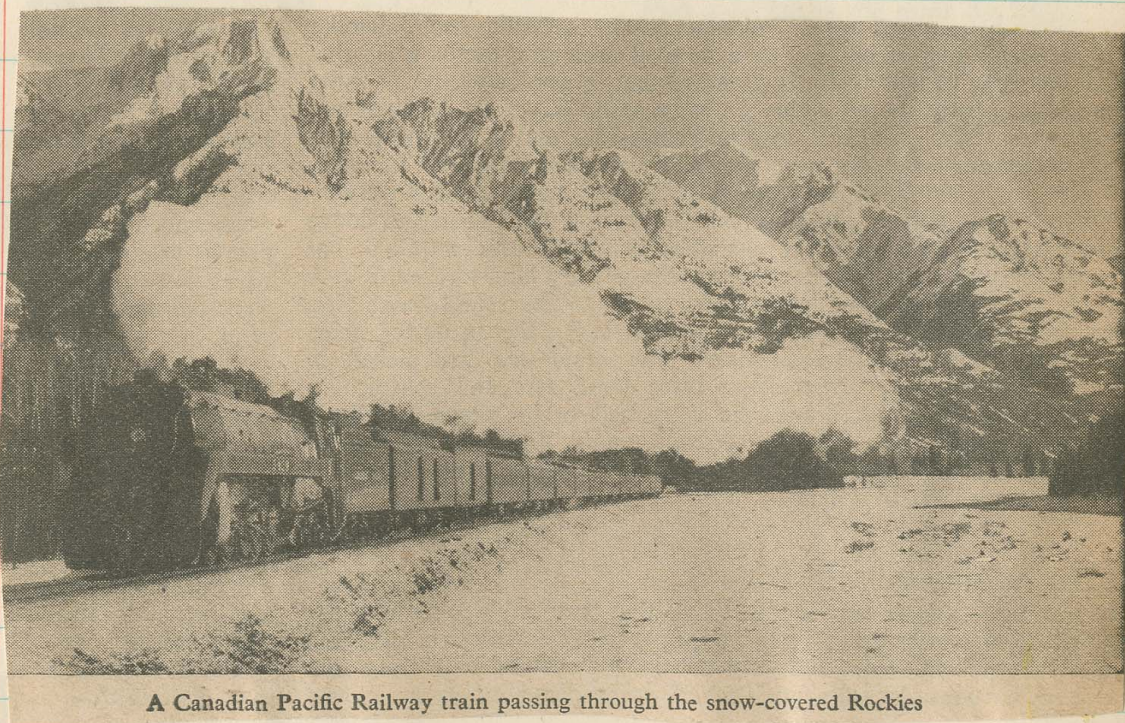

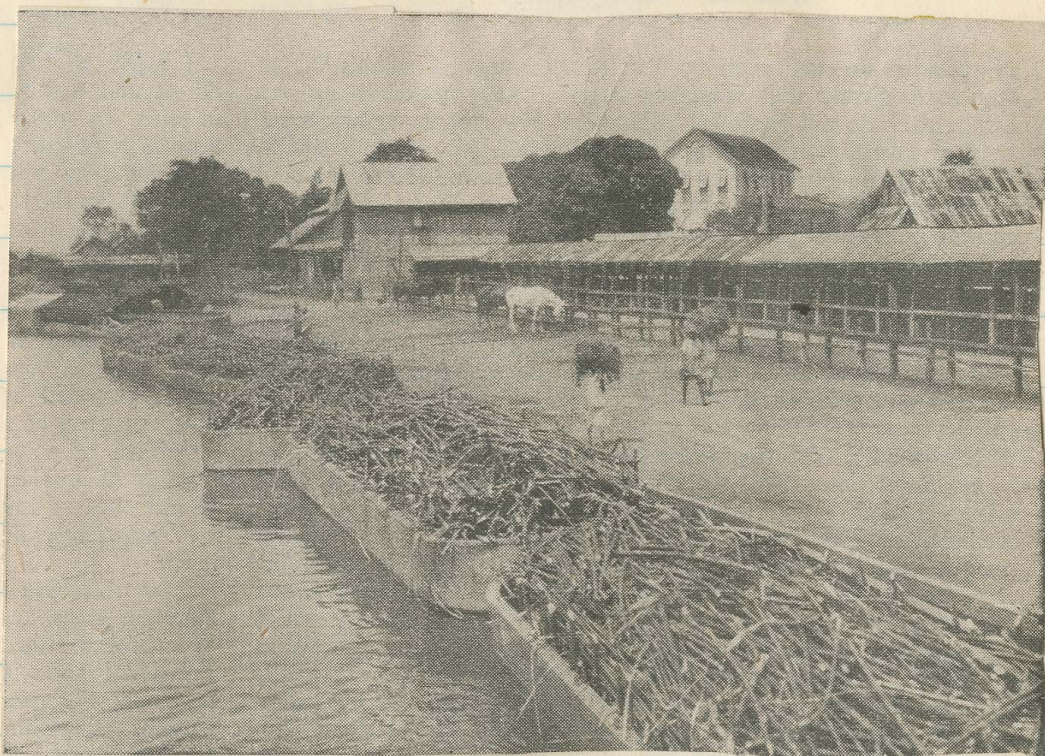

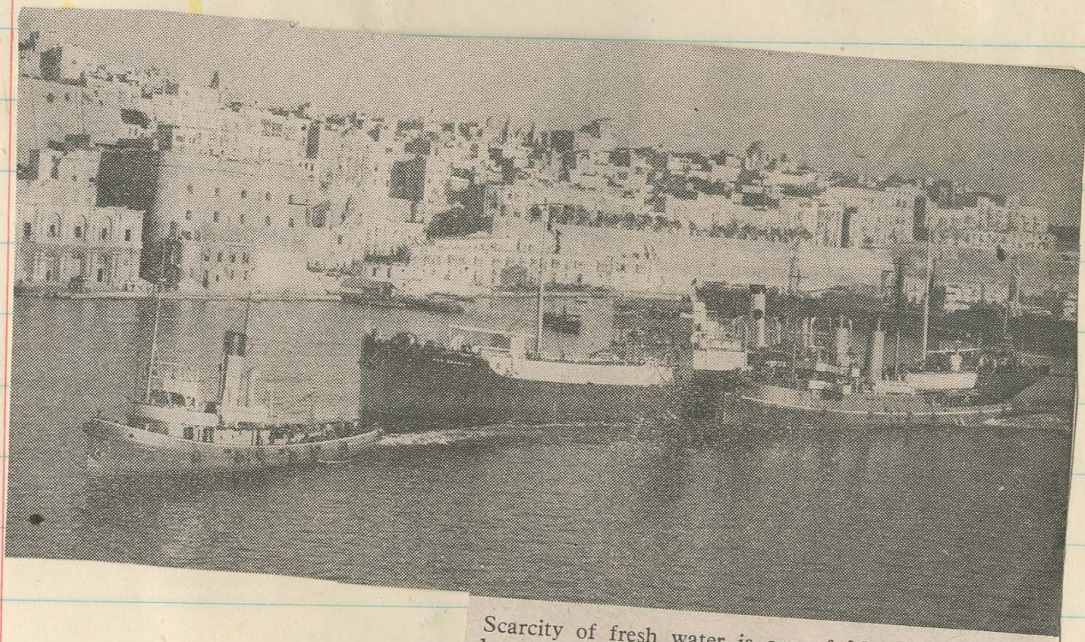


Donkey Ride in Libya
