















Jaytee's waiting behaviour



Jaytee's waiting behaviour in Wiseman and Smith's tests







Telepathic experiences


Sex differences

- Survey of 1671 people
- Similar results in UK, Germany, USA and Argentina
- Almost all experiences were with friends or family members










Telephone telepathy tests


- New way of testing for telepathy
- Highly significant positive results
- No effect of distance
- Higher hit rate with familiar callers
- Replicated at the Universities of Amsterdam and Freiburg and in Nolan sisters experiment
- Ideal for student projects
- In agreement with common experience




Filmed email telepathy tests

Automated email telepathy test




Email telepathy tests

Automated SMS and telepathy tests




Mobile telephone telepathy tests with and without delays
